Dear Parishioners

We will soon be in the month of November and will be celebrating the Holy Day of All Saints on $1^{\rm st}$ November and All Souls on $2^{\rm nd}$ November. This is the traditional month of prayer for the Holy Souls and there are now envelopes available for your Holy Souls lists which we will then read out at each of the masses in November. The offerings that you make will be used by our St Vincent De Paul Society to help local people who are in need. We will also be arranging our annual Mass for those who have died in the last year and will be sending out invitation letters to families over the next couple of weeks. The Mass will be on Saturday $25^{\rm th}$ November. We will light candles for all those who died this last year.

Next weekend is the Coventry Half Marathon, which goes past the church on Sunday morning, $29^{\rm th}$ October. Please be aware of some of the road closures around Christ the King. The Saturday evening Mass is unaffected and it's usually cleared away before the 12 noon Mass, so please plan accordingly. If you are at the 9am, you can park nearby and pedestrian routes are still available.

We will soon be starting our preparation for the Sacraments. The children will be receiving their Mass Diary books before half term and will begin their regular masses of preparation along with Talks for their parents. The children at non-Catholic schools will begin their preparation in the New Year. If you have any children not in our schools who need to be prepared for Communion or Confirmation, please let us have their names and collect a Mass Diary book from the office. The First Confessions will be on Wednesday 6th March for Christ the King School and Thursday 7th March for St Augustine's. First Communion will be on Saturday 11th May for St Augustine's and Saturday 18th May for Christ the King. Confirmations will be Saturday 8th June for Christ the King and Saturday 15th June for St Augustine's. There will also be a separate service on Sunday 19th May at 3.00pm for those attending non-Catholic schools.


