This weekend we celebrate Remembrance Sunday. It is a time to remember the ultimate sacrifice paid by those who gave their lives for the cause for the freedom that we now enjoy. At each of the masses, we will have a moment of silent remembrance. I will be also taking part in the City Remembrance Service at the Memorial Park on Sunday at 11.00am. The children who are making their Communion this coming year will also be receiving their Rosary Beads as we have been working on the theme of "Prayer" and today is a fitting day to remember to pray for those who gave their lives and also to continue our prayers for the Holy Souls. This Tuesday, we have a Mass at 1.00pm in Holy Family Church for the Deceased Clergy of the Deanery. All are welcome to attend. There are refreshments after the Mass. During the month of November, we have our time of prayer for the Holy Souls. We have our envelopes available for your Holy Souls intentions and will read names each day from the Book of Remembrance. Please let us have your envelopes back as soon as possible. There is a box at the back of the church or post it through the presbytery letter box. The offerings that you make will be used by our St Vincent De Paul Society to help local people who are in need. We will also be arranging our annual mass for those who have died in the last year and will be sending out invitation letters to families over the next couple of weeks. The mass will be on Saturday 25th November. We will light candles for all those who have died this last year.
