We will have a session for our Eucharistic Ministers on 9th March, led by Fr Cecil Rogerson. This week, we have our Preparation Meetings for the Sacraments. Each parish and every parishioner will need to look at how we plan to flourish in the future, acknowledging that there may be fewer clergy and that there may be more opportunities for people to be involved in the life of the parish. Our Parish Report this year will reflect some of our hopes for the future.

We do need to recruit some more church cleaners for Christ the King, so please don't sit back and let others do the work. If you have an hour to spare every month, you could be of great help.
