Dear Parishioners

We continue our Lenten Journey and I encourage you to make use of some of our extra masses and the opportunity for Stations of the Cross. The red sheet sets out the programme for the next few weeks. We had a lovely trip to Oscott College last Sunday and we thank all those at Oscott College who made us so welcome.

We are starting to make arrangements for our pilgrimages this year. We already have 20 of our young people travelling to Lourdes from Monday 27th May to Saturday 1st June. We are hoping to travel with the Diocese to and from Birmingham with direct flight into Lourdes, so no coach transfers needed. The cost staying at the Alba Hotel will be £900 for parishioners sharing. The Single Supplement is £150. This is for full-board. Please book with the office if you would like to go. We require a deposit of £100. We are also looking at the Santiago Pilgrimage, possibly in September (Sunday 22nd September to Sunday 29th September) and again in April 2025 (beginning Sunday 27th April to Sunday 4th May). We are looking at 7 days flying from Stansted into Santiago. The cost would be approximately £1,000. Please let us know if you are interested by contacting the office.

As you know during Lent, myself and Fr Benedict will be preaching on the theme of "Prayer" and focusing on the words of the "Our Father". Pope Francis has asked us to meditate on the "Our Father" and to see 2024 as a Year of Prayer, helping us to prepare for the Jubilee of 2025. This week we will be focusing on the second phrase of the Our Father, "Thy kingdom come, thy Will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven". We have a monthly Carmelite Prayer Group session. This will include the morning mass, the Holy Hour with Confessions and a meeting on Carmelite Spirituality. The next meeting is on Saturday 2nd March and thereafter will meet on the first Saturday of every month. There is also a series of talks on "Prayer" provided by the Diocese.
