Dear Parishioners

Thanks for your support of our Lenten Programme. This week the children are making their First Confessions. We have the First Confessions for the children at Christ the King on Wednesday $6^{\rm th}$ March at 6.00pm. There will be visiting priests available to hear the parents confession. On Thursday at 4.30pm, we have the First Confessions for the children at St Augustine's, and again visiting priests will be available for the parents. The children at non-Catholic schools will have their First Confessions on Wednesday $13^{\rm th}$ March at 5.00pm. It is a good reminder to all of us the importance of Confessions and the need to come to Confession sometime during Lent. It is not something that any of us find easy, but it is something we should take seriously and not keep putting off. We have a Penance Service with visiting priests on Monday $25^{\rm th}$ March at 7.00pm. This is the beginning of Holy Week and a good way to prepare for Easter. Please make a resolution to try and come.

We are starting to make arrangements for our pilgrimages this year. We already have 20 of our young people travelling to Lourdes from Monday 27^{th} May to Saturday 1^{st} June. We are hoping to travel with the Diocese to and from Birmingham with direct flight into Lourdes, so no coach transfers needed. The cost staying at the Alba Hotel will be £900 for parishioners sharing. The Single Supplement is £150. This is for full-board. Please book with the office if you would like to go. We require a deposit of £100. We will have a cutoff date of Monday 25^{th} March for final numbers.

We are also looking at the Santiago Pilgrimage, possibly in September (Sunday 22^{nd} September to Sunday 29^{th} September) and again in April 2025 (beginning Sunday 27^{th} April to Sunday 4^{th} May). We are looking at 7 days flying from Stansted into Santiago. The cost would be approximately £1,000. Please let us know if you are interested by contacting the office.

As you know during Lent, myself and Fr Benedict will be preaching on the theme of "Prayer" and focusing on the words of the "Our Father". Pope Francis has asked us to meditate on the "Our Father" and to see 2024 as a Year of Prayer, helping us to prepare for the Jubilee of 2025. This week we will be focusing on the second phrase of the Our Father, "Thy kingdom come, thy Will be done, on Earth as it is in Heaven". We have a monthly Carmelite Prayer Group session.
