This week we begin our journey through Lent. Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and we have four masses to choose from. They are 9.30am mass at Christ the King and St Augustine's and a 12 noon and 7.00pm at Christ the King. There will be the Blessing and Distribution of Ashes at all of the masses. Please try to come along. It is half term, so the schools will not be attending, but we hope families will be able to bring the children to mass. We have our Lenten Programme and the "Walk With Me" booklets and calendars for you to collect. Please use these during Lent and encourage others to do so. This Lent we will be focusing on the theme of "Prayer" and we have various initiatives and resources to help you. There are leaflets at the back of the church. We have a monthly Carmelite Prayer Group session. This will include the morning mass, the Holy Hour with Confessions and a meeting on Carmelite Spirituality. There is also a series of talks on "Prayer" provided by the Diocese.
