and the next one will be this Monday 29th at 4.30pm in the Library. These classes are for children of primary school age. Fr Benedict will be arranging a meeting for older children who are preparing for Confirmation and who are at secondary school. Please let us know as soon as possible if you will need your children to attend this class.

The next Carmelite Prayer Group session will be Saturday 10th February. This will continue once a month on Saturday mornings. This will include the morning mass, the Holy Hour with Confessions and a meeting on Carmelite Spirituality. These initiatives are to help us as we begin a Year of Prayer when Pope Francis has asked us to focus on our prayer life and particularly meditate on the "Our Father". I will speak over the next month about our vision for the parish and how each of us have an important role to play. Each parish and every parishioner will need to look at how we plan to flourish in the future, acknowledging that there may be fewer clergy and that there may be more opportunities for people to be involved in the life of the parish. Our Parish Report this year will reflect some of our hopes for the future.


