Dear Parishioners

This weekend, we are offering Mass for all those who have died over the past year. We have written to invite the bereaved families to come to our 6.00pm Mass this weekend and we will light candles for all those who have died this last year. May they all Rest in Peace. We are grateful to the Bereavement Group for helping organise this Mass and if anyone would like any support in their time of bereavement, please do let us know and the Bereavement Group is here to help. We will continue to read from the Book of Remembrance during the month of November. The book will be on the Sanctuary for the month. The donations will be given to the St Vincent de Paul Society, supporting local people in need. For the weekend Masses, the Holy Souls box will be at the back of the church but during the week you can post your envelopes through the presbytery letter box, or hand it in with the offertory collection.

This weekend, we ask you to continue to support the campaign to vote against the Assisted Suicide Bill. I have sent off the petitions to the Local MP. You may be aware that a new translation of the Lectionary is about to be launched to be read at all Masses from the First Sunday of Advent. We will have new Mass books with the readings and the Eucharistic Prayers included. This should help us in our prayer and participation in the Mass.

The Altar Missals for Christ the King have already been donated by a family and if anyone wants to donate the Missals for St Augustine's in memory of a family member, please let us know. We are also happy to receive donations for the individual parish Mass books used by the congregation.

At the moment we are having some concerns about the Chaplaincy cover at UHCW. At a recent Deanery Meeting, the Clergy proposed that we express our concerns to the hospital Chief Executive. The Catholic Chaplain needs more support and the Catholic staff and patients need the assurance that their spiritual needs are being met. We will be organising a petition next week to be sent to the hospital expressing the concerns of the Catholic community in Coventry.

Next weekend we celebrate the Parish Feast of Christ the King and it's a day when we focus on the youth work in the parish as it is World Youth Day.
