Dear Parishioners

This weekend we Commemorate Remembrance Sunday and we join with people in honoring those who gave their lives in warfare. We remember all those who died in battle, but also those killed as a result of war in many different ways. We also remember the families left behind to mourn their loss. We use today to pray for peace and are conscious of the wars that are still waged at the moment. As well as our Remembrance at Mass this weekend, we will also have Remembrance Services on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November at both our schools.

At the 9.00am and 10.30am Masses this Sunday the First Holy Communion children will be receiving their Rosary Beads as a reminder of the importance of prayer and remembrance. The dates for the Sacraments are First Holy Communion, St Augustine's on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> May and for Christ the King on Saturday, 17<sup>th</sup> May 2025. First Confessions will be on Wednesday, 19<sup>th</sup> March for Christ the King at 6.00pm and at St Augustine's on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> March at 4.30pm. Confirmations will be Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> June for Christ the King and Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> June for St Augustine's.

We have begun our Commemoration of the Holy Souls and we will be reading out the names from the Book of Remembrance at each of the masses through November. Please let us have your Holy Souls envelopes with the names of the deceased so these can be included in the Remembrance Book. The book will be on the Sanctuary for the month. The donations will be given to the St Vincent de Paul Society, supporting local people in need. Miraculously, the Holy Souls Box was found by a parishioner, dumped in Jubilee Crescent. So we will use it over the weekend only and it will be brought in after the weekend Masses. During the week you can post your envelopes through the presbytery letter box, or hand it in with the offertory collection.

The Annual Mass for those who have died this last year will be on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November at 6.00pm. We have written to all the bereaved families from the last year

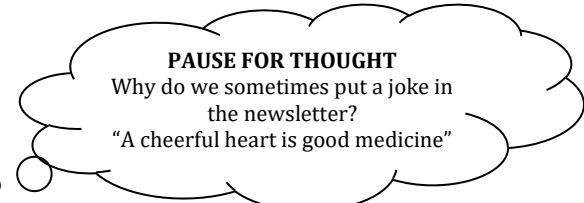
